

# 30 Days Free Technical Support for Your Digital Education Platform from Stone

In partnership with Microsoft and the DfE Funding Initiative

**The DfE has launched an initiative to help schools transition to remote learning platforms during the Coronavirus (COVID-19) pandemic.**

An industry coalition headed by Microsoft and its partners - including Stone, are to support the DfE providing remote e-learning platforms, devices and connectivity, for educational establishments across England.

Subject to eligibility, the scheme offers grants of up to **£2,000** to schools to help fund the implementation of a 'Digital Education Platform'.

If you are eligible, you will also receive **30 days free technical support** from Stone.

## AM I ELIGIBLE?

**Schools that want to access the scheme and grant funding need to meet some minimum criteria, they are as follows:**

1. Schools in England with a partially provisioned or without a **Microsoft Office 365** or Google Suite digital environment will be eligible for funding to help them implement a Digital Education Platform for a fixed cost of £2,000 per platform.
2. Schools in England in a Multi-Academy Trust (MAT) of up to 10 schools will be eligible for £1,000 per school to configure a MAT wide approach (single platform for whole MAT).
